TRAVEL INFORMATIONS!

The closest airports are: Rimini; Bologna; Forlì; Pisa (but you can also fly to Milano or Roma).

Then, you need to get to Rimini (there are many trains, website: <https://www.trenitalia.com/en.html>).

From Rimini train station to the facility, you can walk for about 25 minutes, or take a city bus.

From Rimini airport to Rimini train station: Bus line n. 9

TRAVEL REFUNDS:

Travel costs will be reimbursed up to the maximum amount indicated by the distance calculator provided by the European Commission:

10-99 km (23 Euro)

100-499 km (180 Euro, 210 for Green travel)

500-1990 km (275 Euro, 320 for Green Travel)

2000-2999 km (360 Euro, 410 for Green Travel)

Travel costs refunds: all travel costs involved for the arrival of the participants in the hosting location will be reimbursed to the sending organization based on the following documents:

Original tickets showing price and name of the participants (or partner organization), including boarding pass. This means that, if a paper ticket is purchased for the return trip, it will need to be mailed to PiGreco-SEMI in the Faenza office;

Invoice (from the sending organization) or Request for refund (from the participants) signed;

The reimbursement will be made into the account provided on the invoice from the sending association, or the Request for refund from the participants, by bank transfer.
