#### THE CONCEPT

Most of the available programs for trainers in youth work focus either on technicalities, tools or only on group dynamics with the same models repeated.

While these models that give the basic of non formal education (e.g. Kolb-cycle) are crucial to know and understand, it is even more important that the knowledge becomes useable in different contexts.

Design your Context supports a learning process that touches the crucial elements and resources of being a trainer, and acknowledges the fact that those elements are interconnected and can be used only if we approach them as a whole system.

develop communication and presentational skills; attitude towards flexibility, ability to handle crisis;




train embodiment method.

#### THE METHODOLOGY

**Experiential learning** or learning by doing is the main aspect of our methodology.

We will provide several inputs, activities and moments for reflection, it is up to you to make the links with your own background. We have no expectation on what or how you should learn. This training is there for you to learn what you want to learn, to draw your own conclusions, so you can implement it after the training course is over.





Springing from this main method we'll use other approaches:

- Embodied awareness
- Self-Directed Learning
- Outdoor learning
- Peer learning
- Group Coaching
- Learning by submerging

#### THE DATES

"Design Your Context" program
consists of:
2 residential trainings;
1 pre-training assignment
Ongoing e-learning;
Ongoing mentoring & coaching sessions
with one of the course trainers.

The dates for the two residential trainings are:

Training 1: Greece, 18-26 October 2024 Training 2: Greece, 04-12 April 2025

**Note**: Participants are expected to attend all of the activities above and to participate responsibly throughout the online work required. In total participants should allocate:

18 residential training days (including travel)

2-5 days for personal/team projects preparation and implementation

1-2 days for coaching & mentoring, personal learning goals, online work from October 2024 to August 2025

- wish to expand their practice or career to include new skills and attitudes in personal development, communication, peacebuilding, conflict management and coaching.
- elevate their performance in youth work and training
- reside in Estonia, Greece, Spain, Romania, Italy, Latvia, Czech Republic, Bulgaria, Croatia or Hungary.
- are able to clearly communicate in English (intermediate level)

You will receive a certification upon completion of the whole course.

#### THE SELECTION

This is an advanced course and participation in both phases is <u>mandatory</u> in order to secure the best results.

We aim to gather a group of participants with varied backgrounds and levels of experience. This will enhance the informal learning process, through the sharing of knowledge and skills between participants.

Priority will be given to those who commit to the 2 training courses and the parallel coaching process, as we believe that maximum learning impact will come from attending the whole learning cycle.

There is a participation fee of **60€** per activity.


#### REIMBURSEMENT IS POSSIBLE UP TO THE FOLLOWING LIMITS:

#### THE VENUE



Accommodation during "Design Your Context" is going to take place in Scout Center "Theodoros Litas".

There is a shelter with bunk beds and all the necessary standards (electricity, toilets, heating, wifi, etc).



Our venue sits atop a 30-acre plateau on Mount Hortiatis, 800 meters above sea level. Accessible via a 4-kilometer asphalt road from the village of Hortiatis, it's conveniently located 30 kilometers from Thessaloniki city and Macedonia airport (SKG).

Surrounded by dense chestnut forests, it offers an ideal setting for scouting activities and exploration, with stunning views of Lake Volvi and Mount Olympus. Numerous paths lead to landmarks like Shelter S.E.O., Zougla, and Peak 1201, providing ample opportunities for adventure.
