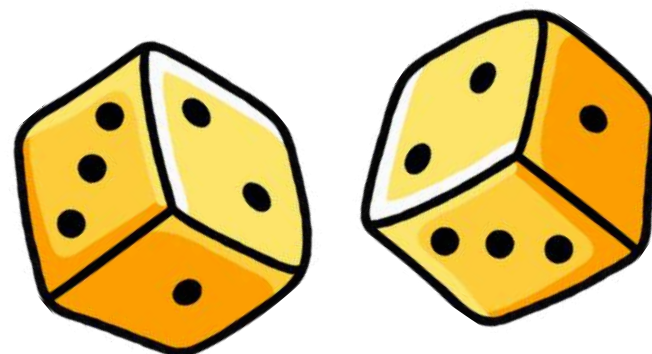

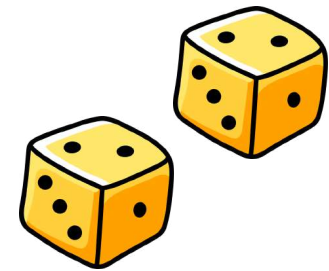
Regarding training course, bring positive attitude, snacks from your countries.

It is possible to extend your stay for a maximum of 2 days in total (1 before, 1 after, or 2 before/after). In case your stay exceeds the 2-day limit, we cannot reimburse your travel expenses and you must come and go from/to your home countries. Any additional expenses, which occur throughout these “extra days”, have to be covered by yourself. Before that, please contact OKO team.

Food is part of students center menu, it means it is fresh, mainly from Serbian culture. We would try our best to follow your applications, but be aware that some things in Serbia is hard to make or find. Bring what you think it could be additional for your nutrition.

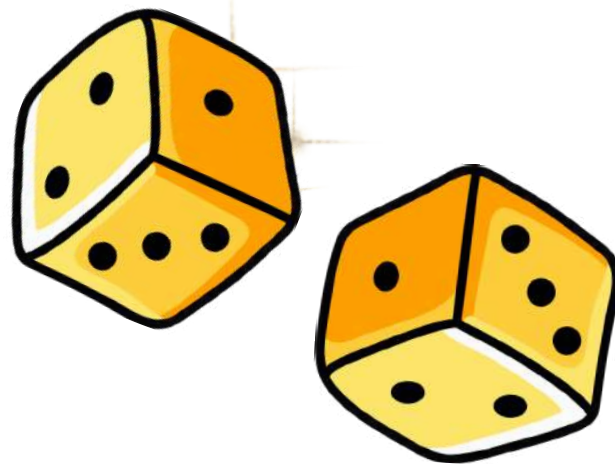

Accommodation is based on 2 or 3 bed rooms, full lodging (with breaks of course) in Students Recreational Centre Avala (<https://usob.rs/>) which is actually part of Belgrade, on small mountain, with a forest behind. There are situated students from all over the world who wants to study Serbian language and prepare for University. It is forbidden to enter restaurant in slippers or flip-flops. In rooms you have additional soaps, hairdryers, towels. But you should bring your toiletries and warm wardrobe.

When arriving to Nikola Tesla Airport in Surčin (or to Belgrade in general), you can take local bus to the city center numbers 601, 602, then take some of the busses: 400, 401, 402, 403, 404, 405 i 450. Ask the driver which station you should change.

Be careful! There are protests now in Serbia, avoid main crowded places and be patient- from 11.52 until 12.07 some days, people are standing still in cities to pay tribute to 15 killed people in Novi Sad in November 2024. See more: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Novi_Sad_railway_station_canopy_collapse. There are places in Belgrade with fences and police which you should avoid.

Also, you need to scan them and send them on oko.refund@gmail.com, no later than 30 days after the training. You need to send clear bank account number, IBAN, SWIFT, full name of account holder. For the local transport we are not reimbursing taxi or private car use.

If you don't send us all above mentioned documents in up to 30 days after the training, we will not be able to refund the travel expenses.

We encourage you to use green travel option (bus, trains), shared carpooling, except where is not possible.
